2009-10 Stanford Achievement Test (SAT) RESULTS REAFFIRM EXCELLENCE IN EDUCATION AT EASTSIDE CHRISTIAN SCHOOL

ALL ECS students in grades 1, 2, 3, 5, 6 & 8 participated in the SAT assessment testing last spring (including students who would be eligible for special education services in public schools). 4th & 7th Grade students took the WASL.

The Stanford Achievement Test is a “Normed” test, meaning the results are calibrated to ensure that the average student scores a 50 (Stanine of 5). Moving large groups of students beyond 50 is difficult to do because of a statistical principle known as regression.

We are very proud of our student, teacher, and family efforts to achieve such a high level of academic excellence. Glory to God!

Percentile rank is a relative standing of ECS students compared with all other students in the same grade who took the test (50 represents the average performance).

An estimate of performance an average student at a grade level demonstrated at a particular time in the school year. 5.8 = Grade 5, 8th month.
